In order to work at the Carleton Pool, you will need current **Red Cross Water Safety Instructor, Lifesaving Instructor, National Lifeguard, Standard First Aid, CPR 'C' and AED** certifications. All of your qualifications MUST be current by **September 15, 2019.** Please attach photocopies of all your quals to your application.

Note: A <u>Police Records Check</u> for working in the 'vulnerable sector,' will also be required for newly hired staff. A Records Check can be completed by Provincial Police or your local Police.

The original certification cards for these quals and any additional qualifications that you list on your application will need to be presented during the Interview process following a positive performance at the **NEW Staff Screening** scheduled for: **Sunday September 8, 2019 (4:45-8:45 PM)**

* Please ensure that your application is submitted either by email, in person at the Welcome Centre in Alumni Hall or at the Pool Office by **Friday September 6, 2019** at **4:00 PM.** An application **MUST** be submitted prior to the Screening.
